

A short report on Indian Export of Wheat

2019-20 to Apr-Feb 2021-22

Indian Export of Wheat

Wheat is the main cereal crop in India. Production of wheat was 107.9 million metric tons (mmt), up by 3% over 2019-20. Wheat production in 2021-22 is estimated between 98 million to 105 million tonnes, lower than the 2020-21 record of 107.9 million tonnes. Wheat is used in India as main food product as well as it is being exported. Table 1 is showing export of wheat in last 3 years.

Table 1 is showing that:

- Total 6.7 million ton wheat was export in Apr-Feb 2021-22 which is already more than total export of wheat in 2020-21 (2.15 million ton).
- From export of wheat, India earned 1942.6 million USD in Apr-Feb 2021-22 which is also more than that in 2020-21 (567.9 million USD) and up by 318.36% over Apr-Feb 2020-21(464.34 million USD).
- Top 12 countries contributed 98% in total export value of wheat in Apr-Feb 2021-22 and its share in this period increased from that in previous 2 financial years (2020-21: 95.81%. 2019-20: 93.71%).
- Out of these top 12 countries share of 8 countries have increased and that of 4 countries decreased.
- In 2019-20, Nepal was top-most destination country, contributing 72% of total value of wheat export but its share reduced largely in 2020-21 (15.9%) and Apr-Feb 2021-22(3.9%). Quantum and value of export of wheat to Nepal has reduced in Apr-Feb 2021-22 by 15.72% and 14.47% respectively over Apr-Feb 2020-21.
- The top-most place was taken by Bangladesh in Apr-Feb 2021-22 and 2020-21 and its share in total value of wheat export was 56.9% and 54.6% respectively. In Apr-Feb 2021-22, quantum and value of export of wheat to Bangladesh has increased heavily by 263.67% and 306.84% respectively over Apr-Feb 2020-21.





Table 2 is showing export of wheat to neighbouring countries:

- For Bangladesh and Sri Lanka, share of wheat export increased in Apr-Feb 2021-22 but for Nepal, Bhutan and Afghanistan this share decreased.
- Total share of these neighbouring countries decreased in Apr-Feb 2021-22 (69.17%) comparing to Apr-Feb 2020-21 (69.84%), 2020-21 (78.42%) and 2019-20 (87.88%).
